Recommendation, Re: Approval of Bid Rejection for Patio Railing

Background information:

FQC (the Library's construction management firm) recommended that the Library reject the bids received on May 24, 2019 for decorative metal railing & fencing. Two bids were received. One bid did not include the concrete work that was part of the scope of work. The other bid received was not read due to insufficient bid security. FQC researched alternate methods for this portion of the renovation project.

Recommendation, Re: Approval of Stainless Cable & Railing Material Quote

Background information:

FQC researched a variety of fencing options and after several meetings and discussions with the Library and the architects it was recommended to purchase fencing and railing product materials from Stainless Cable & Railing, Inc. in the amount of \$13,829.03.

Recommendation, Re: Approval of Mechanical and Industrial Steel Installation Quote

Background information:

FQC recommended hiring Mechanical and Industrial Steel Services to provide the installation of the fencing and railing materials for the Library's north patio in the amount of \$19,960.00.
