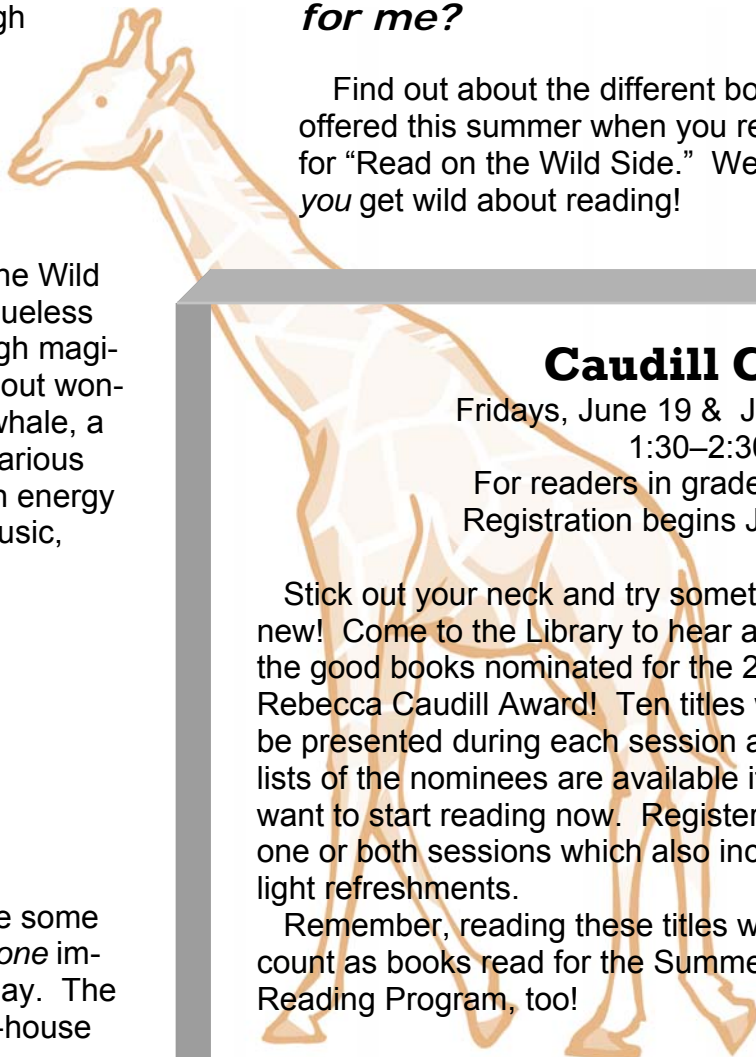
Summer Chess Club
