Saturday Chess

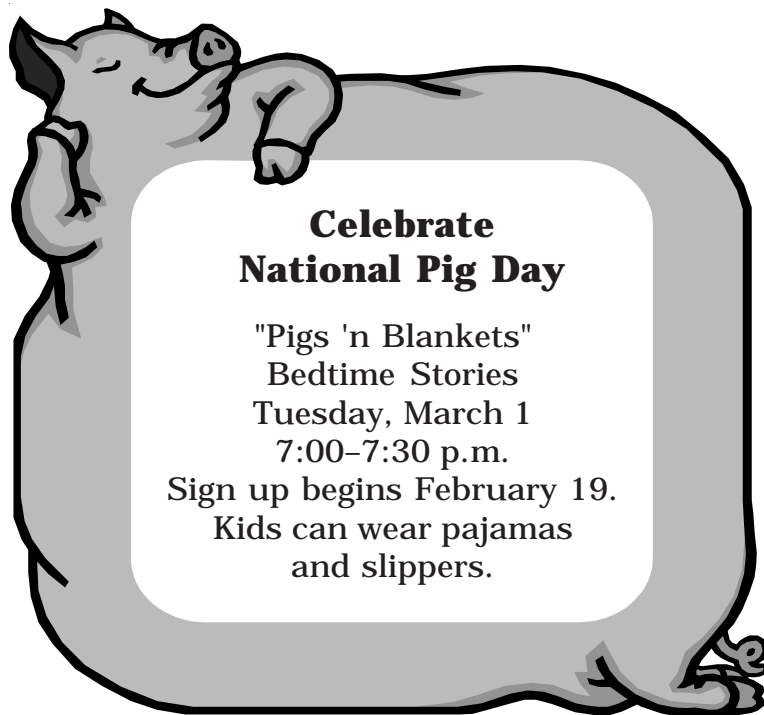

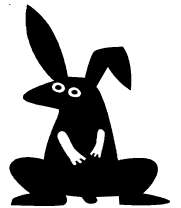
Calling all Poets
