All movies are rated PG except *Spider-Man 2* (PG-13). Covered drinks and dry snacks will be allowed in the Community Room.

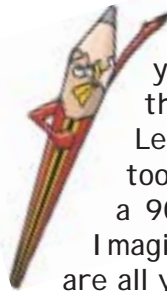
### Superhero Cartooning
