La Parakata: The arrival of the butterfly

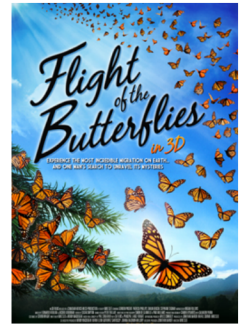
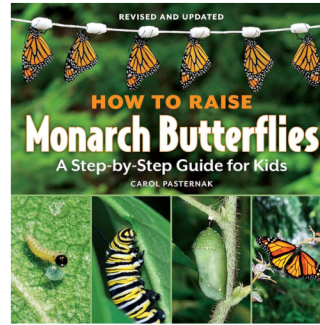
